Health Care Reform Alert from the U.S. Bishops

Congress continues to debate and work on health care reform legislation. While the House-passed version of the bill prohibits the use of federal funds to pay for elective abortions, the Senate-passed version requires that federal funds (your tax-dollars) be used to pay for health plans that cover abortions. Congress is now in the process of combining these two bills into one.

The U.S. Bishops strongly oppose any legislation that promotes or pays for abortions and does not respect the dignity and sanctity of every human life, born and unborn. It is also imperative that any legislation contain a "conscience" clause that protects Catholic and other health care providers who refuse to perform procedures and provide services which violate Catholic moral teaching and their consciences.

It is important that Catholics exercise their responsibilities and rights as citizens. Your immediate prayers and action are necessary. Please visit www.usccb.org/healthcare to find practical information about how you can help. The U.S. Bishops are asking you to contact your congressional representatives immediately and urge them to protect the lives, dignity, conscience and health of all. Health care should save lives, not destroy them.

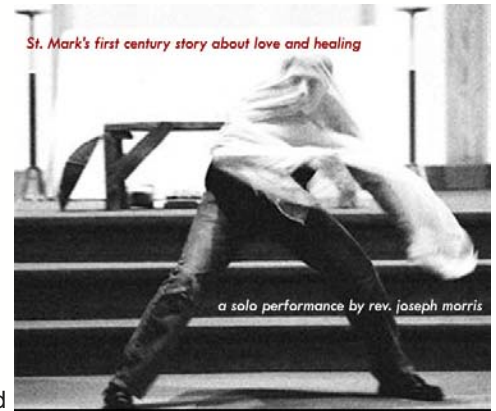
SPC Performing Arts Series Presents...

Sunday PSR cold weather carpool will change to minimize outside time for children and staff. Children will wait inside the doors, not outside as usual. This process takes much longer since we only load one or two cars at a time and despite our best efforts, noise levels in the hallway do not allow us to quickly get a child to the door.

Carpool tips for cold/inclement weather days (SUNDAY CARPOOL AT BLESSED TRINITY HS)

1. The quickest way for pick-up is to walk in and get your child at the classroom door no later than 5 minutes before the session dismisses.
2. At 5 minutes before the end of the session, all children will be moved to the back hallway.
3. You may walk in to get your children in the back hallway - a staff member will be posted at the door to assure safe exit.
4. Cars will be loaded one at a time through the doors AFTER the halls are reasonably clear of adults entering to pick up their children.
5. Cars waiting in line will only be loaded after all children whose parents walk in for pick up have exited.
6. You may have a long wait until carpool begins to move.
7. We strongly recommend carpool for families that have young children already in the car as well as those with physical limitations.
8. **Drop off remains the same** - a staff member will be posted just inside the doors in bad weather and outside when weather permits.

Thanks for your cooperation; we will conduct normal carpool whenever weather permits.

Not sure about the weather? We rarely cancel Sunday sessions due to weather.

If you are unsure, however, please check your email since we will email you on Sunday Morning if sessions are cancelled.

Closings will also be posted on 11 Alive TV and on our church website.
