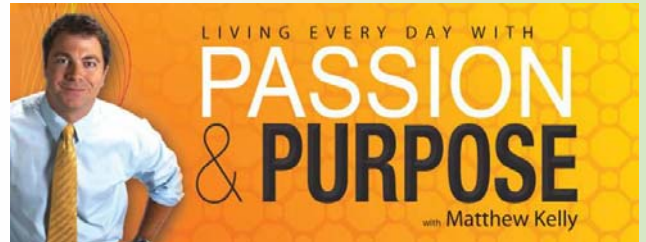

Every person's journey is different, but all you need to do is take that first step. We hope and pray that you do.
