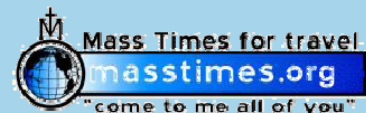

## HOW DO I BECOME CATHOLIC?

The community of St. Peter Chanel welcomes anyone who is interested in joining the Catholic Church. Each year we conduct two series of classes that lead people through the process of becoming members.

If you have never been baptized, we will help you to prepare for the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.

If you have already been baptized in a non-Catholic Christian Church, we have a series of classes to help you to prepare for Confirmation and Holy Eucharist, the means by which you will enter into full communion with the Catholic Church.

If you are unsure if this journey is right for you, the initial classes will provide you with information to help you decide. We will do all that we can to be sure that your questions are answered.

Both series of classes are part of the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA). This is a process by which adults, after hearing the mystery and good news of Jesus Christ proclaimed, seeks to enter the way of faith and conversion within the Church as guided by the Holy Spirit who opens their hearts. Every person's journey is different, but all you need to do is take that first step. We hope and pray that you do.
