From the Pastor:

Feast of Christ The King

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King which was instituted at a time (1925) when respect for Christ and the Church was waning. Pope Pius XI hoped that the feast would offer strength and courage to the faithful as we are reminded that Christ must reign in our hearts, minds, wills, and bodies. This celebration is fittingly placed at the end of the liturgical year so that we observe the Kingship of Christ right before Advent, when we liturgically wait for the promised Messiah.

Last Saturday several individuals celebrated the Sacraments of Christian Initiation, coming into full communion with the Catholic Church. Congratulations and Welcome! I look forward to your active involvement with your parish family. I would also like to congratulate all those who walked this journey with them. The RCIA process is one that relies heavily on the parish community assisting with the preparation and formation. While I am frequently told that the sponsors and presenters often feel that they have gotten more from the process than they gave, their involvement is so important. So for those who helped along the way - thank you!

HAPPY THANKSGIVING on Thursday. Once again our nationally designated day of giving thanks is upon us. While I don't think that it is good practice to wait for Thanksgiving to offer appreciation, I do think that it doesn't hurt to take advantage of every opportunity to acknowledge good works. So on this Thanksgiving I want to thank everyone in the parish without whose contributions St. Peter Chanel would not be such an outstanding Catholic parish. I encourage you to thank those around you, especially your families. Gratitude is one of those things that is always welcome.

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church

1421 The Lord Jesus Christ, physician of our souls and bodies, who forgave the sins of the paralytic and restored him to bodily health, has willed that his Church continue, in the power of the Holy Spirit, his work of healing and salvation, even among her own members. This is the purpose of the two sacraments of healing: the Sacrament of Penance and the Sacrament of the Sick.

1532 The special grace of the Sacrament of the Sick has as its effects:

- ♦ the uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his own good and that of the whole Church;
- ♦ the strengthening, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age;
- ♦ the forgiveness of sins, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of Penance;
- ♦ the restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his soul;
- ♦ the preparation for passing over to eternal life.

- ♦ You are contributing weekly to St. Peter Chanel Catholic Church by use of either parish envelopes or E-Giving system. *We should have your current Treasure Pledge on file.*
