The Archdiocese of Atlanta asks that all its parishes assist with financial support for the Catholic Schools. It also requires that parents of Catholic School students be active, involved, and supportive members of their home parishes. Here at St. Peter Chanel we ask the following of our Catholic School parents: that

- ◆ You participate at Mass every Sunday with your family;
- ◆ You have been registered for at least 3 months. If you are new to the area, you are asked to provide a letter from the pastor of your former parish regarding your involvement and support;
- ◆ You are involved as a parish member and volunteer in a parish ministry. *This is indicated by your current completed Time and Talent Form, which we maintain on file;*
- ◆ You are contributing weekly to St. Peter Chanel Catholic Church by use of either parish envelopes or *E-Giving* system. *We should have your current Treasure Pledge on file.*

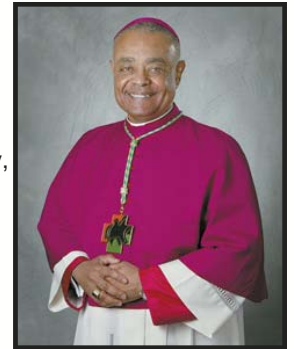

The purpose of the Elijah Cup, a consecrated Chalice, is to provide a focal point for prayer.

In 1 Kings 17, during a drought, Elijah tells the poor widow of Zarephath that if she makes him a small loaf of bread with the last of her flour and oil, her "jar of flour will not go empty, nor the jug of oil run dry, until the Lord sends rain upon the earth." In faith, the widow baked the bread and fed Elijah. For the next year, the widow, her son, and Elijah ate bread made from the bowl of flour and jug of oil.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Each week the Priest Celebrant of the Mass will call a family, individual or couple forward to receive the Elijah Cup. They receive a blessing and take the cup home, along with the photo of St. John Vianney, putting it in a place of honor.

Each day for a week, during prayer they pray for an increase and perseverance of vocations.

The following week, at the same Mass, they return the Cup to the table in the back of the Church and are called by the Priest Celebrant to bring the gifts forward to the Altar.

Please prayerfully consider bringing the Elijah Cup to your home for a week of family prayer for vocations. Please call or e-mail your time and date preferences.

The commitment is small ... the reward everlasting!

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

“Come after me...” - Matthew 4:19

In our crazy, success-driven, materialist world we all get caught up in chasing after many dreams, wants and ambitions. Yet, with three simple words, Jesus tells us clearly that the only one we should be following after is Him. *“Come after me,”* is not just an invitation that Jesus extended to the first apostles. It is an invitation that He extends to each of us every day of our lives.

Due to the inclement weather and the early transmittal of this bulletin, the Offertory reports for January 9th and 16th were not available.

ARE YOU 70 1/2 YET?

Congress renewed a special tax benefit for holders of IRA's who happen to be 70 and 1/2 years old.

Distributions from an IRA owned by an individual who is at least 70 1/2 years old, which otherwise would have been taxable, will be excluded from gross income if made to an exempt organization like St. Peter Chanel. These tax-free roll over gifts may be any amount up to \$100,000 per year. This option is also available to ROTH account holders. It allows you to avoid paying tax on your IRA distribution. And of course St. Peter Chanel would receive the full benefit, which we can use for our parish operations and ministries. It could also go to underwrite a Window or other significant donation. You decide the purpose to which you wish to contribute.

Because Congress acted so late in 2010 to pass this legislation, you can make a gift from your IRA until January 31, 2011, and still elect for it to count as a gift and as your minimum required distribution for 2010. To take advantage of this opportunity for tax year 2011, you must act by December 31, 2011.

To qualify:

- You must be age 70 1/2 or older at the time of gift.
- Transfers must be made directly from a traditional IRA account by your plan provider to St. Peter Chanel. Funds that are withdrawn by you and then contributed do NOT qualify.
- Your plan administrator may make the check out to St. Peter Chanel and mail the check to you. But you must postmark the check to us by January 31, 2011, for this tax year, or December 31, 2011 for the 2011 tax year.
- Gifts must be outright. Distributions to donor-advised funds, certain supporting organizations, or life-income arrangements such as charitable remainder trusts and charitable gift annuities are not allowed under this program.

As with all tax matters, it is a good idea to consult your accountant or financial advisor before making a distribution. For more information contact Tom Blond in the Business Office.



If you are over 65, would like to receive **additional income**, need a **tax deduction** and at the same time would like to make a **gift to your parish endowment fund**, a **Charitable Gift Annuity** may be the perfect answer. The rate of return you receive is based on your age and is set by the American Council on Gift Annuities. For instance if you are 70, you would receive 5.7%; if you are 80, you would receive 7.1%; and if you are 90 or older, you would receive 9.5%.
