- ~ Anyone who is seriously ill.
- ~ Those who are chronically ill (heart, arthritis, asthma, etc.)
- ~ Those who are convalescing or temporarily ill.
- ~ Those who suffer from weakness due to age.
- ~ Those who are preparing for surgery in the near future.
- ~ Seriously ill children who have reached the age of reason.

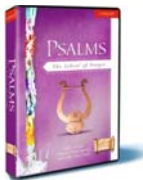
