### FROM THE PASTOR:

As Catholics we celebrate Easter not just last Sunday, but throughout the Easter Season all the way to Pentecost. During this time we hear once again, the stories of Christ's disciples as they cope with His death and resurrection. In today's Gospel, Thomas seeks proof of the resurrection which he receives when he is invited to see and touch Christ, and to believe. Today our "proof" comes in His being present to us and in His offer of peace. It comes to us through the community of believers who reinforce for each other that Jesus is, indeed, alive and among us because his Spirit is within us and calls us to live life fully. In that spirit, I ask you to consider participating in the parish blood drive which will take place on Sunday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>. As Catholics we hold that all life is sacred. Our donations to the blood bank at St. Joseph's Hospital, helps put actions to our words. Directions to register and reserve a time for your donation are in the box on the next page.

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday, a feast established by Pope John Paul II. He granted this feast to the universal Catholic Church on the occasion of the canonization of Sr. Faustina. How appropriate that the pontiff who championed the gift of Christ's mercy and compassion, should himself be beatified, one step closer to canonization, on Divine Mercy Sunday. I invite you to take one of the John Paul II commemorative holy cards as a remembrance of his beatification and a reminder to follow his call of love, service, justice, and mercy.

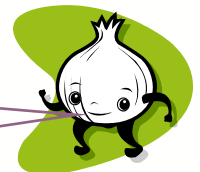

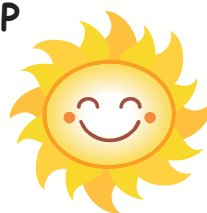

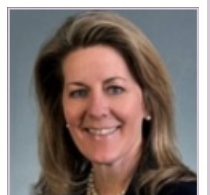

### ***Do you have questions about joining the Catholic Church?***

At the Easter Vigil we welcome a number of new people into the Catholic Church through The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). RCIA is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the Sacraments of Initiation - Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church.

The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church He founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful.

The RCIA process is a restoration of the ancient Catechumenate, arising within the first three centuries following the era of the apostles. It was the early Church's way of Christianizing the pagan Roman Empire. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church.
