From the Pastor

I am pleased to announce that the 2013 Mass Intention Book is open and with this opening come some changes. It is our tradition as Catholics that we pray for others, for special intentions, and especially for those who are deceased. The greatest prayer that the Church can offer is the *Holy Sacrifice of the Mass*. It is here that we are united in community with the Lamb of Sacrifice, Jesus Christ. The graces that are shared offer tremendous consolation to those in need.

The Church allows that a Mass can be offered for one special intention when the Mass is celebrated. Here at St. Peter Chanel when you request a special intention, we provide a Mass Card that you can send that will inform the recipient of the date and time.

The *Holy Sacrifice of the Mass* is indeed a unique prayer, a special prayer. The suggested donation for weekday Mass will be \$20.00 for the year 2013 and \$25 for Sundays or Holy Days. This suggested amount is in keeping with the surrounding parishes and reflects our appreciation of the value of the gift of the *Holy Sacrifice of the Mass* and does not put it on par with a Hallmark card.

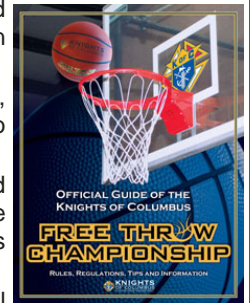

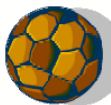
