Our Preschool Program

The Preschool program at St Peter Chanel Catholic Church was established in 2003. In our first year, we served just over 40 children. Today we have over 120 children and offer classes for children 18 months through 4 years of age.

Each class is led by a teacher and an assistant who are screened and approved by the Church and the Archdiocese. All of our staff are required to participate in continuing educational workshops for early childhood professionals.

The number of children enrolled in each class is based on the age of the children and the facility space.

Children are challenged to learn through hands-on activities in the classroom that encourage them to play, explore, imagine and create at their developmental level.

Our Preschool Program also includes:

- “Bible Heroes” - Children learn about important people from the Bible. We celebrate Jesus’ birthday in December and remember Mary with flowers in May.
- Music and Movement – Children learn to move and express themselves in our monthly Program. Our Music teacher expands upon classroom topics through song and dance and frequently creates songs just for the children!
- Monthly Enrichment Programs - For example a story teller, a puppet show, science enrichment and live animal experiences.
- Community Service - Bringing canned goods for St Vincent DePaul Food Pantry, purchasing flowers to honor Mary to support the ProLife Ministry, and several trips to St George Village for our 4’s classes to visit the elderly.
- St Peter Chanel Preschool Parent Council – This group of parent volunteers enables all Preschool families to get involved through many events that encourage fellowship, including Family Fun Night, Teacher Appreciation Week, Trunk or Treat and a Day at the Ballet.

St Peter Chanel Preschool is supported by the Parish of St Peter Chanel serving hundreds of families in our area. Many of these families come to Preschool and find a home in St Peter Chanel, where “We are Family”

Special Notes

St Peter Chanel Preschool operates independently from Queen of Angels Regional Catholic School. Attendance in the preschool program in no way affects or guarantees admission to Queen of Angels Catholic School.

St Peter Chanel Preschool is an “Exempt from State Licensing” program and is under the supervision of the Archdiocese of Atlanta Office of Catholic Schools. SPC Preschool operates under the Guidelines for Parish Early Childhood Programs and receives at least two Quality Assurance Visits each year. Class Information

Children are eligible for classes based on their age as of September 1. All children will bring a lunch to school each day.

18-24 Month Olds – School Hours: 9:30 – 12:45

(Child must be 1 yr old by March 1 and walking by the first day of school)

- Mon/Wed - **\$165 per month**
- Up to 10 children per class/ 2 teachers

2 Year Olds – School Hours: 9:30 – 1:00

- Tues/Thurs (2 day) **\$165 per month**
 - Mon/Wed/Fri (3 day) **\$225 per month**
- Up to 10 children per class/ 2 teachers

3 Year Olds: School Hours 9:30 – 1:00

(Child must be potty trained, without the use of pull-ups, by the first day of school)

- Mon/Wed/Fri (3 day) **\$225 per month**
 - Tues/Thurs/Fri (3 day) **\$225 per month**
- Up to 12 children per class/ 2 teachers

4 Year Olds: School Hours 9:30 – 1:00

- Mon-Thurs (4 day) **\$275 per month**
 - Mon-Fri (5 day) **\$300 per month**
- Up to 14 children per class/ 2 teachers

Admission to the 5 day program will be based on length of time enrolled in SPC Preschool and age of the child.

Registration

Registration forms are available on the St Peter Chanel Catholic Church website: www.stpeterchanel.org or from our Preschool Office. Forms for the upcoming year will be available starting in mid-January.

Registration takes place in early February. Parents do not attend registration. Classes will be filled on a priority lottery basis. This means *currently enrolled* children and their siblings are first, followed by St Peter Chanel parishioners then the general public. Registration forms may be returned to the Preschool Office at any time before priority group's deadline:

- Currently Enrolled Students: **February 1**
- St Peter Chanel Parishioners: **February 2**
- General Public: **February 3**

Early registration forms will be held until the applicable group's deadline. If there are more registrations than spaces available within a priority group, we will utilize a "lottery" and the children will be randomly picked for the available spots.

A registration fee of \$100 is due with your registration form. Included in this fee is the cost of a tote bag for your child, for the school year. This fee is non-refundable once your child is confirmed in a class.

Your first of nine tuition payments is required by April 16, 2012 (or upon registration during the school year). This will be credited towards May, 2013 tuition or the last month, whichever comes first. September 2012 tuition will be due the first week of school. May 2013 tuition is non-refundable for withdrawals between April and August. During the school year, at least one month's notice is required for any refund considerations.
