Service Project Reflection Form - 10th Grade

Because Christian service is integral to mature Christian faith, candidates for Confirmation are required to participate in parish related projects with the intention of stimulating a lifelong habit of awareness and service. It is the expressed intention of the Archdiocese of Atlanta that sacraments be celebrated within the parish family. Therefore, all Sacrament of Confirmation requirements must be exclusive to and directly affiliated with St. Peter Chanel Catholic Church.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

- Candidates must complete 2 service projects in 9th Grade and 2 service projects in 10th Grade;
- Confirmation service projects must be voluntary; therefore, grades, payment, and/or rewards of any kind may not be accepted.
- Confirmation service projects may not fulfill other school or ministry service requirements.

- Opportunities for Confirmation service projects are posted in the Church Bulletin periodically. They may include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - Usher, Eucharistic Minister, Lector, Altar Serving
 - Assisting in the Church Nursery during Mass time
 - Assisting the ministry staffs during special events, sacrament celebrations, or preparations for seasonal church celebrations
 - Vacation Bible School aide
 - PSR teacher aide
 - Parish sponsored volunteer activities at local shelters or nursing homes
 - ALIVE sponsored service activities such as 30-Hour Famine or Catholic Heart Work Camp

- Please note that the following activities DO NOT fulfill the requirement for Confirmation service projects:
 - Personal or family related service, such as babysitting, housecleaning, etc.
 - Cleaning up trash from local parks or roadways
 - Boy Scout or Girl Scout activities or service hours
 - Mission trips associated with other churches
 - Christian Athletic Group activities
 - Beta Club activities

- Upon completion of each Confirmation service project, the Candidate must complete the brief reflection summary on the back side of this form.
