Over the years, the practice of selecting a Confirmation Name has changed. Today, the trend toward taking a Confirmation Name is growing and we witness many candidates placing significant value on this traditional practice. The Confirmation Name chosen by the candidate is typically associated with a saint, a religious role model, or a biblical hero. In some cases, a candidate may choose to use his/her own Baptismal name. In any case, the candidate should understand the meaning of the chosen name and the name's relationship to a particular saint.
